Design Area: 31w x 34h (1.9" wide x 2.1" high)

Model: 32ct Antique White Belfast Linen:

(Cut fabric: Approx 8" x 8" for pincushion)

Symbols Fibres and Beads

Gloriana #134 "Summer Smoke" - blue, green, cherry, gold
Needlepoint Inc. #0771 - yellow

BUNDLE B

- ✓ Gentle Art "Raspberry Parfait" - multi reds (French Knot)
- Kreinik Mori #0434 - green med lt
- Kreinik Mori #4166 - blue green

BUNDLE C

Kreinik Mori #4206 - green med
Kreinik Mori #4077 - green dk

BUNDLE D

- SJ Designs petite bead #18116 - red

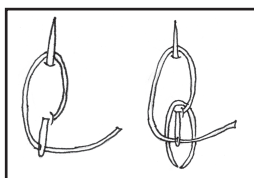


Diagram D. Chain Stitch

2. TENDRILS: Using 1 strand of Kreinik Mori #4206 green med work Stem Stitch for the tendril shown as a solid line on Main Chart. **Diagram E.**

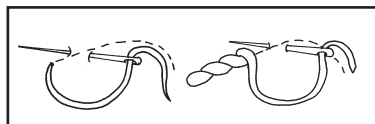


Diagram E. Stem Stitch

3. TENDRILS: Backstitch the tendrils shown as a dark dotted line on Main Chart, with 1 strand Kreinik Mori #4077 green dk.

4. SUNFLOWER: Work twenty-four Bullion Knots in a circle with 2 strands of Gloriana silk #134 "Summer Smoke" as shown on Main Chart and diagram. **Diagram U1. To Start Stitching a Bullion Knot:** Come up at A as shown diagram. In one motion, bring your needle down at B and back up at A again, taking care not to slide needle all the way through the linen. Allow the needle to stop 3/4 of the way up through the linen. Now wrap the thread around the exposed tip of the needle 10 - 12 times. **Note:** It is helpful to have the first finger of your other hand under the needle holding the wraps to keep the wraps from slipping off, and to keep your wraps even. Now, holding the wraps with same finger, gently pull the needle through the wraps towards B. Arrange Bullion to lie flat against the fabric between A and B. Finally, bring your needle down through the fabric at B. Repeat for the next Bullion Knot. **Diagram**

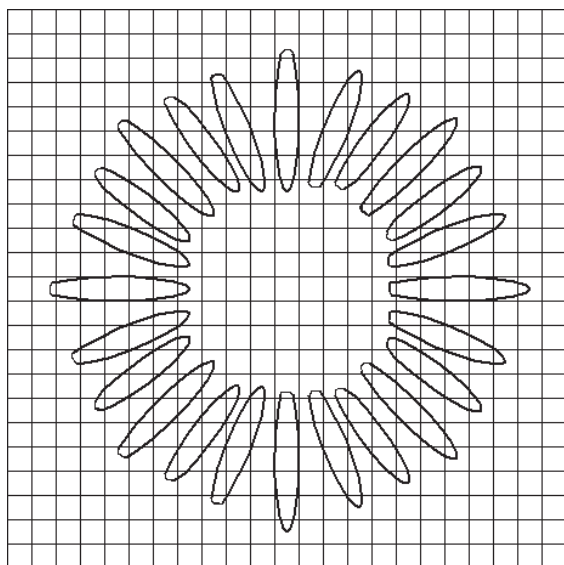
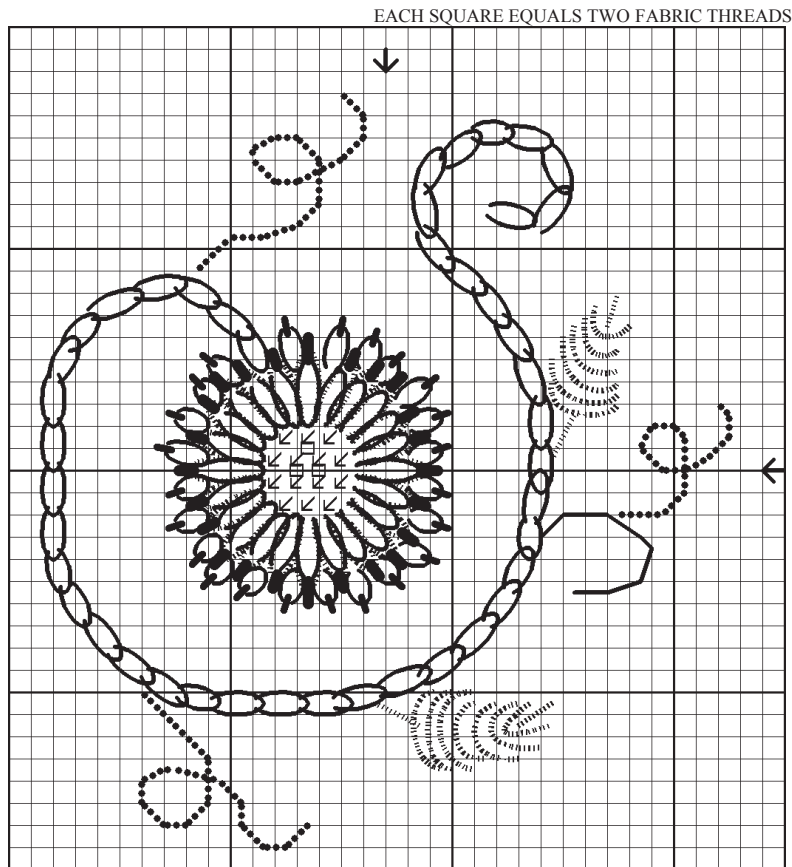


Diagram U1. Bullion Knot Placement

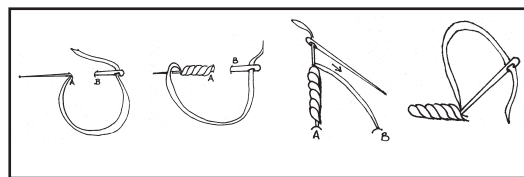


Diagram U2. Bullion Knot

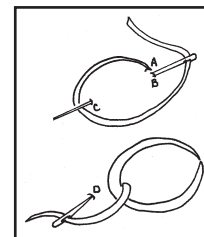


Diagram H. Lazy Daisy

U2. Using 1 strand of Kreinik Mori #4166 blue green work Lazy Daisy stitches around each Bullion Knot, as shown on Main Chart and **Diagram U3.** Work Lazy Daisy stitches for the outside petals with 2 strands of Needlepoint Inc. #0771 yellow. **Diagram H.** Using 2 strands of Gentle Art "Raspberry Parfait" work French Knots in the centre of the Sunflower as shown on Main Chart. **Note:** Wrap thread around needle twice for each French Knot. Attach SJ Designs petite bead #18116 red with 1 strand of Gentle Art "Raspberry Parfait" according to symbols on Main Chart. Go through each bead twice to ensure stability.

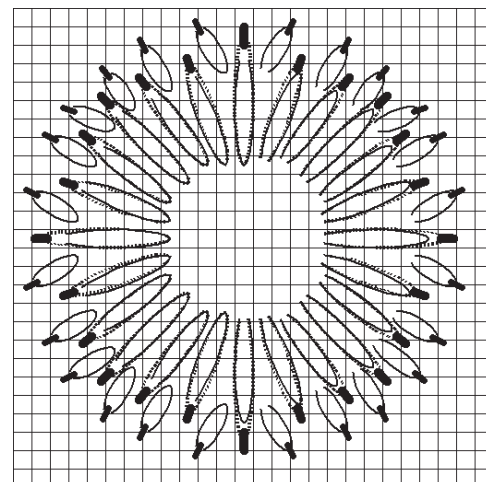


Diagram U3. Lazy Daisy Placement

5. FLY STITCH LEAVES: Using 1 strand of Kreinik Mori #0434 green med lt to work Fly Stitch leaves.
