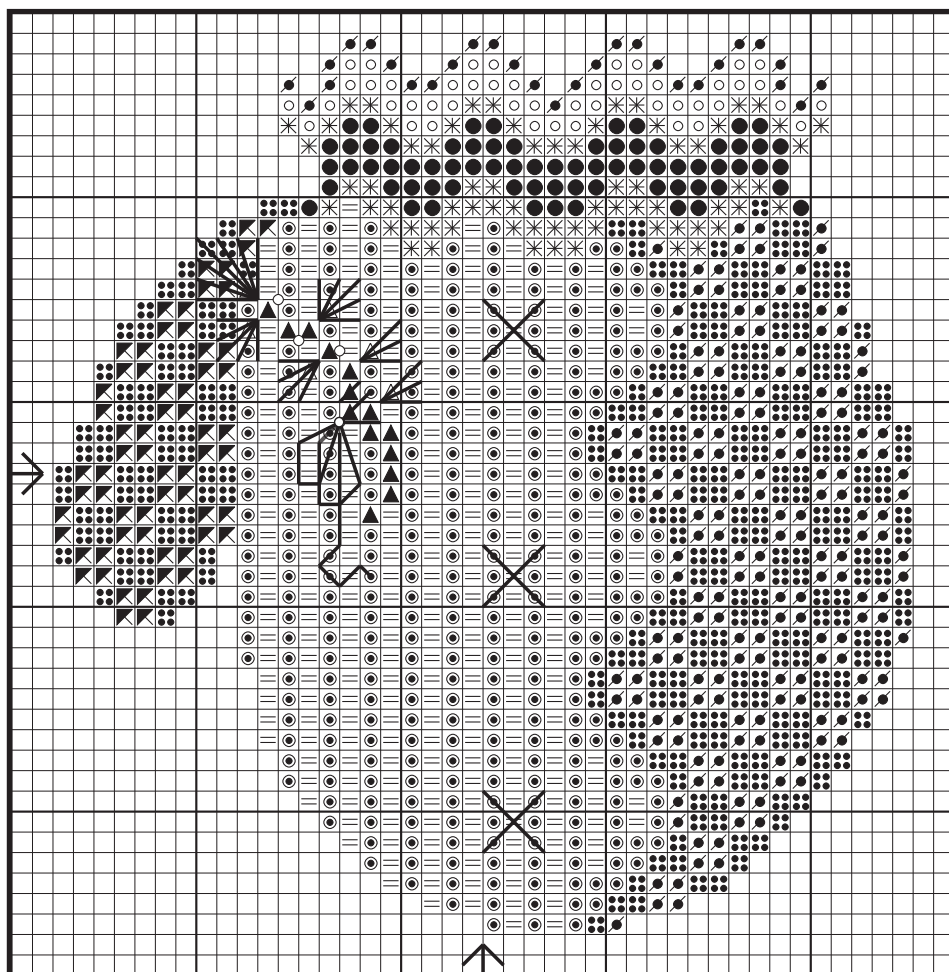




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It's all about the buttons!

"Baby, It's Cold Outside" is a mitten in name only; it thinks it's an overcoat with big, bold buttons to "secure the perimeter" against the chill winter wind. Three buttons are needed. Any buttons of the appropriate size make good candidates. I chose to work with a selection from JABCO's extensive offering. When making your selection, remember it's fun to rummage through the button box for odd or interesting refugees.

—We suggest you approach your selection process as follows:

1. Choose your buttons first.
2. Adjust the floss colors in the Color Code to coordinate with your buttons. Small changes may be all you need.
3. Choose the fabric. Lay your buttons and floss on the fabric to check compatibility. PLEASE be inspired to do it - your way!

DESIGN AREA 42W X 44H

10 count [work: 4 ply floss]4.2 X 4.4

15 count [30 linen] [2 ply].....2.8 X 2.9

Linen worked over two threads.

BUTTONS

For a mitten worked at 10/12 stitches per inch; choose buttons measuring 5/8 to 3/4 inches. For 14/15 stitches per inch; 7/16 to 1/2 inch buttons work best. The mitten is color coordinated with the following buttons from Just Another Button Co. The coloring of the Up-Town version teams well with three black and white swirls, while the cottage-y colors of the three floral buttons create a Shabby Chic feel. Attach buttons at large X's.

[1] LC 1032#

[1] LC 1022

[1] LC 1030

*Use the extension .M for work at 10/12 stitches/inch and .T for 14/15 stitches/inch.

*Use the extension .L for work at 10/12 stitches/inch and .S for 14/15 stitches/inch.
